## Four Groups

The **day camp** will consist of three groups:

- Group 1: Ages 5-8
- Group 2: Ages 9-11
- Group 3: Ages 12-14

The **evening camp** (Group 4, ages 15-18) will consist of 27 players (14 forwards, 10 defensemen, and 3 goaltenders). This group will be made up of aspiring high school and midget players. Players who have completed high school are not eligible.

## Schedule

The **day camp** will begin as early as 7:45 a.m. and conclude as late as 5:15 p.m. for some, but not all groups, Monday through Friday. Students will skate two times per day, and **will have the opportunity to purchase a weekly lunch plan**. Goaltenders will receive instruction from a goaltending coach.

The **evening camp** will begin at 6:00 p.m. and commence at 8:30 p.m. each evening, Monday through Friday. Players will have a high intensity practice followed by a scrimmage from 7:15 – 8:30. A dryland and/or lecture precedes on-ice instruction at 6:00.

## Need to Know

**All students** must have full hockey equipment, including a mouth guard, neck guard, and approved helmet/mask. All students need to have shorts, tennis shoes, and a shirt for dryland training. We encourage bringing a spare stick for ball hockey.

Students will receive a hockey jersey, schedule, and locker room and group assignments. Check in will take place as follows:
